**Real Estate Transactions**

Course objectives include providing students: (i) basic knowledge and fundamental conceptual tools needed to understand standard real estate transactions; (ii) learning accepted terminology and relevant economic considerations to discuss typical aspects of real estate transactions; (iii) examining how real estate practitioners and courts analyze legal risks and issues commonly presented in real estate transactions; and (iv) become familiar with the structure and purpose of documents commonly used in real estate transactions and the remedies and processes that are generally available to enforce the rights and obligations of the parties. PFBH's cornerstone achievement is its acquisition and development of a mixed-income neighborhood, The Homes at Willow Bend, which develops and sells quality-built residences to first time and lower income homeowners. PFBH partners with several area lenders to provide favorable terms to facilitate homeownership for working-class families.

I negotiated their acquisition and construction financing, have worked with other community partners in various lines of credit and grant programs, developed restrictive covenants for the Homes at Willow Bend subdivision, provided guidance on various contractual negotiations and resolution of disputes, and introduced relationships with area lenders to partner with PFBH to provide loans to potential home buyers.




